From Prison Cell to 500 Libraries: Planet Word Hosts Reginald Dwayne Betts for a Freedom Reads Milestone

Event marks the launch of the 500th Freedom Library, created by poet and lawyer Reginald Dwayne Betts

WASHINGTON, D.C. — **Planet Word** will **host 500 and Counting! A Freedom Reads Celebration** on Saturday, September 13, 2025, at 4:00 p.m., featuring poet, lawyer, and MacArthur Fellow Reginald Dwayne Betts. The free event will celebrate the launch of the 500th Freedom Library, a milestone in Betts's nonprofit initiative Freedom Reads.

The program will include a reading by Betts, an overview of the work of Freedom Reads, an exhibition of the Freedom Library, and a community reception.
