## Michele Norris on Our Hidden Conversations

Thursday, May 30, at 6:30 p.m.

Peabody Award-winning journalist Michele Norris will speak about her new book, *Our Hidden Conversations*, on Thursday, May 30. This compilation of stories, essays, and photographs was gleaned from her decade-long work on <a href="The Race Card Project">The Race Card Project</a>. Michele will lead the audience in an interactive presentation about the complexities of race and identity and the importance of an empathetic ear.

## **Timothy Shriver on The Dignity Index**

Friday, September 13, at 6:30 p.m.

Timothy Shriver, Ph.D., Chairman of the Board of the Special Olympics, will present on <u>The Dignity Index</u> on Friday, September 13. He will offer insights into how The Dignity Index, an eight-point scale that scores speech along a continuum from contempt to dignity, aims to foster respectful dialogue by focusing on the words, not the people behind them.

"Words matter," said **Ann Friedman, CEO and Founder** of Planet Word. "We see this axiom play out every day in our civic life, in our schools, and around our kitchen tables. Too often in recent years, by choice or by chance, words have become weapons. This new and timely series illuminates a fundamental and powerful truth: Each of us has a choice in how we use our words in ways that are constructive or destructive, helpful or hurtful."

Subsequent programs in the lead-up to the November election will be announced. Each hour-long program will conclude with a Q&A session with the audience at Planet Word's Friedman Family Auditorium.
